



Proposition 301 expenditures were 3.78 percent of the District's \$33,535,103 current operating expenditures in fiscal year 2002.

#### District-reported 2002 results

- On average, each teacher earned an additional \$3,150 in salary.
- Teachers accomplished school performance goals such as improving student achievement on standardized tests; implementing Proposition 203 requirements; receiving North Central Association accreditation; increasing parental involvement; and personal goals such as earning 3 master's level class credits; tutoring students; and maintaining classroom attendance at 95 percent or higher.
- 6 counselors were hired to identify student learning issues and to increase school/parent contacts.
- 6 physical education teachers were hired. This allowed the classroom/grade level teachers additional planning time to work on implementing state standards and district-aligned curriculum.
