



# Proposition 301

#### District-reported 2008 results

- The District did not employ any teachers, and thus, did not spend base and performance pay monies. However, the District used approximately \$15,046 in menu monies to pay for a dropout prevention program for 127 students through Northland Pioneer College.
- The District continues to seek ADE guidance on the allowable uses of its accumulated \$595,436 balance of Proposition 301 monies. Base and performance pay monies account for \$419,515 of the accumulated balance.
- The District's students attend NAVIT courses held at Northland Pioneer College. Therefore, the District does not employ any teachers, and its classroom expenditures consist primarily of tuition payments to the college.
