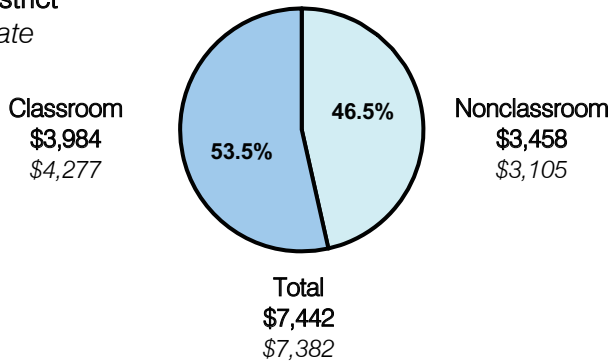

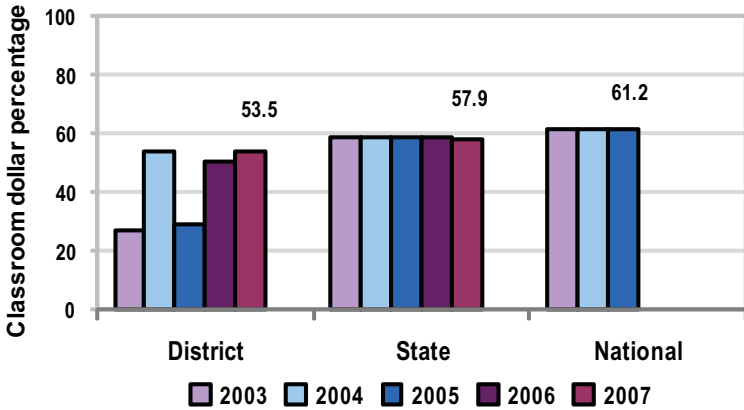

Proposition 301

District-reported 2007 results

- The District did not employ any teachers, and thus, did not spend base and performance pay monies. However, the District used approximately \$52,000 in menu monies to pay for a dropout prevention program for 117 students through Northland Pioneer College.
- The District continues to seek ADE guidance on the allowable uses of its accumulated \$435,699 balance of Proposition 301 monies. Base and performance pay monies account for \$314,645 of the accumulated balance.
- The District's students attend NAVIT courses held at Northland Pioneer College. Therefore, the District does not employ any teachers, and its classroom expenditures consist primarily of tuition payments to the college.
