




5-year spending trend (2010 through 2015)

Total operational spending per pupil, adjusted for inflation, increased by 1 percent. The percentage of dollars spent in the classroom varied year to year, decreasing overall from 49.3 to 48.9 percent. Overall, as a percentage of total spendina. transportation operational increased substantially and plant operations and instruction support increased, while administration decreased substantially.


Total operational and instructional spending per student (inflation adjusted to 2015 dollars)




Changes in operational spending percentages






Plant cost per square foot and square footage per student
