

#### 5-year spending trend (2009 through 2014)

Total spending per pupil decreased by 4 percent. Spending in the classroom decreased overall from 52.3 to 49.1 percent. Overall, spending on instruction support increased substantially, spending on plant operations increased, and spending on administration increased slightly. Spending on most other nonclassroom areas varied year to year.










# Total operational and instructional spending per student




### Changes in operational spending percentages






