



Teacher pay

 On average, each teacher earned an additional \$7,723 in salary, and each instructional aide earned an additional \$452.

Performance

- The District accomplished most of its goals, which were similar to the prior fiscal year's goals and were based on individual performance.
- Teachers met most of the student achievement goals, which were based on standardized test scores.
- Teachers also attended at least 90 percent of all district in-service hours or completed at least 50 hours of approved professional development, which could include conferences, workshops, college courses, and district curriculum development.
- At least 70 percent of parents surveyed gave the District satisfactory ratings.
- Teachers made at least 8 contacts with each student's parents during the school year.
