






5-year spending trend (2012 through 2017)

Total operational spending per pupil, adjusted for inflation, increased by 8 percent. The percentage of dollars spent on instruction increased overall from 55.8 to 57 percent. Overall, as a percentage of total operational spending, instruction support decreased and administration and food service decreased slightly, while student support increased slightly. Other noninstructional areas remained stable.


Total operational and instructional spending per pupil (inflation adjusted to 2017 dollars)






Financial stress assessment




Administrative cost per pupil
