



Teacher pay

 On average, each teacher, librarian, and counselor earned between \$6,000 and \$7,700 in additional salary, and each instructional specialist earned an average of \$1,900.

Performance

- The District accomplished most of its goals, which were the same as the prior fiscal year's goals and were based on school and individual performance.
- Each school earned a "Performing" or better label from ADE for AZ LEARNS.
