



## District-reported 2008 results

Teacher pay

• On average, each teacher earned an additional \$3,343 in salary, the counselor earned an additional \$2,960, and the librarian earned \$540.

#### Performance

- The District accomplished some of its goals, which were based on district and individual performance.
- Teachers reviewed each student's needs and progress so that instruction and support services could be modified accordingly.
- Student attendance increased over the previous year, and parent attendance increased during open houses, parent information meetings, and parent-teacher conferences.
- Teachers attended character education training and implemented character education lessons in the classroom.
- Teachers also coordinated extracurricular activities at the school.

#### Menu

- Monies were used to provide one-on-one instruction in the areas of math, science, and reading for AIMS intervention.
- Monies were also used to increase eligible employee compensation.
- 1 counselor earned additional money for an attendance incentive.
