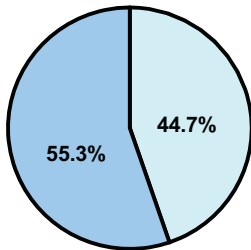

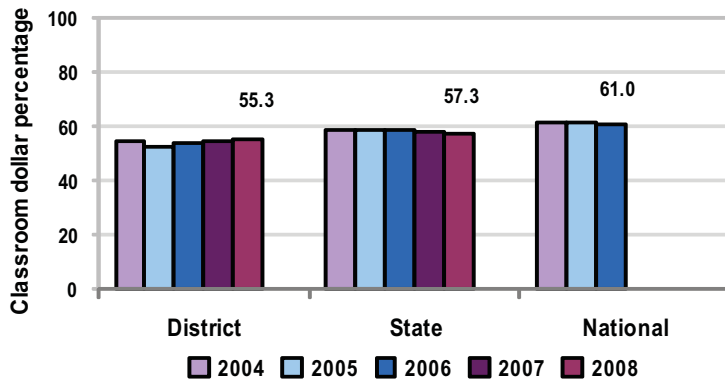

District-reported 2008 results

Teacher pay

- On average, each teacher earned an additional \$4,459 in salary.

Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were similar to the prior fiscal year's goals and were based on district and individual performance.
- At least 50 percent of students obtained a score of "Meets" or "Exceeds" on the AIMS test in reading and math.
- New teachers must have received 2 satisfactory performance evaluations and continuing teachers must have received 1 satisfactory evaluation to earn performance pay.
- Teachers used district assessment plans that are aligned with state standards to demonstrate student proficiency on the state standards.
- Other goals were linked to leadership activities, continuing education, and peer collaboration.
