



Teacher pay

• On average, each teacher, librarian, speech pathologist, audiologist, counselor, literacy and math coach, and reading specialist earned an additional \$4,901 in salary.

Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on fiscal year 2006 school and individual performance.
- The student achievement goal was linked to AZ LEARNS and Adequate Yearly Progress objectives and students' standardized test scores.
- Teachers completed at least 40 hours of approved professional development activities and used 6 or fewer discretionary absence days per year.
