

#### 5-year spending trend (2009 through 2014)

Student enrollment decreased by 39 percent, which contributed to the 34 percent increase in total spending per pupil. Spending in the classroom varied year to year, increasing slightly overall from 66 to 66.1 percent. Spending on administration increased substantially, while spending on instruction support decreased substantially.
