



Teacher pay

• On average, each teacher earned an additional \$5,878 in salary.

Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on school performance.
- 72 percent of students who remained in the detention facility for at least 1 week achieved a score of 80 percent or higher on a life skills posttest.
- Students who remained in the facility for 30 days or more increased their reading and math scores by more than 10 percent on pre- and post-tests.
- Teachers each participated in 30 hours or more of professional development activities.
