

### District-reported 2003 results

#### Teacher pay

 On average, each teacher, speech pathologist, and counselor earned an additional \$3,984 in salary.

#### Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on school performance.
- On average, 74 percent of students' standardized test scores exceeded the national average for reading; 75 percent exceeded the national average for math; and 71 percent exceeded the national average for language.
- Additionally, 60 percent of students achieved mastery on district writing assessments.

#### Menu
