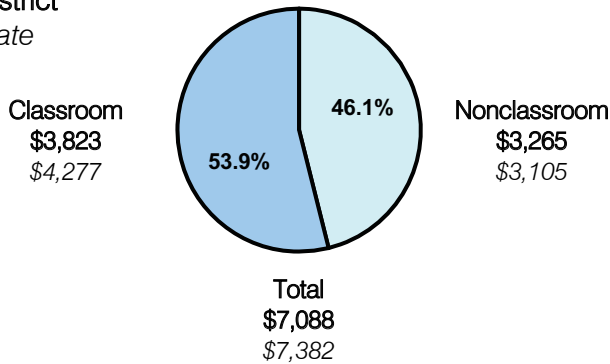

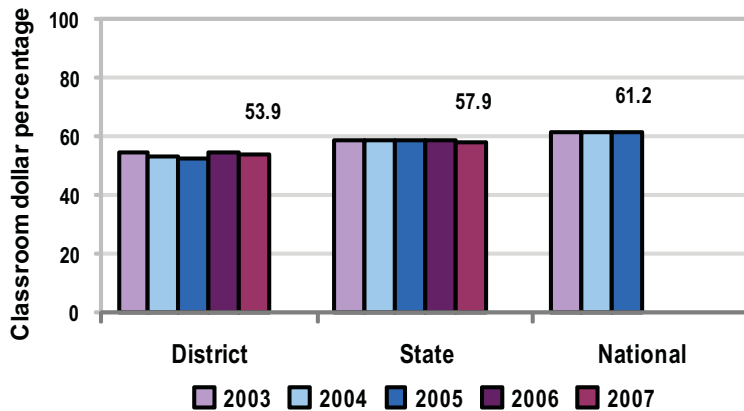

District-reported 2007 results

Teacher pay

- On average, each teacher earned an additional \$4,161 in salary.

Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were similar to the prior fiscal year's goals and were based on district and individual performance.
- At least 50 percent of students showed 1 year's academic progress as measured by AIMS test scores.
- More than 60 percent of parents surveyed gave the District satisfactory ratings.
- Teachers received \$60 for every college credit they earned during the school year.

Menu

- Monies continued to be used to compensate teachers for additional duties, such as classroom preparation, meeting with parents, and implementing a new reading program.
