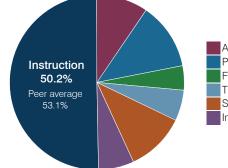

Spending by operational area



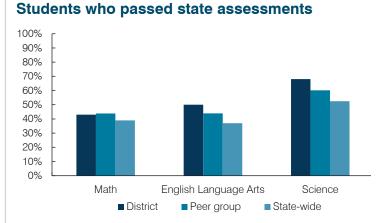

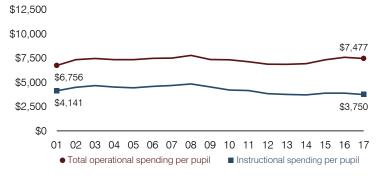

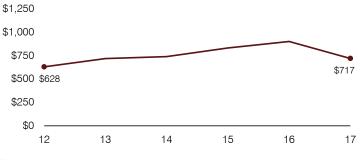
5-year spending trend (2012 through 2017)

Administrative cost per pupil

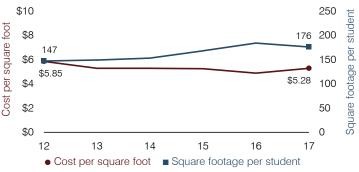
Total operational spending per pupil, adjusted for inflation, increased by 9 percent. The percentage of dollars spent on instruction decreased from 55.7 to 50.2 percent. As a percentage of total operational spending, student support and instruction support increased substantially and transportation increased slightly, while plant operations and food service decreased slightly. Administration varied year to year.

Total operational and instructional spending per pupil (inflation adjusted to 2017 dollars)

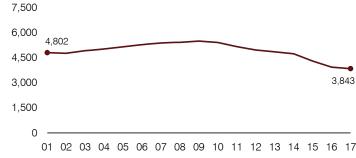




Plant cost per square foot and square footage per student



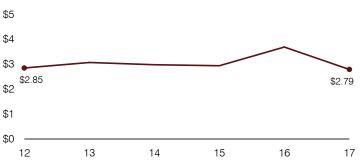

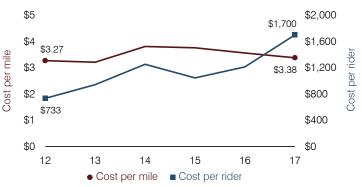
