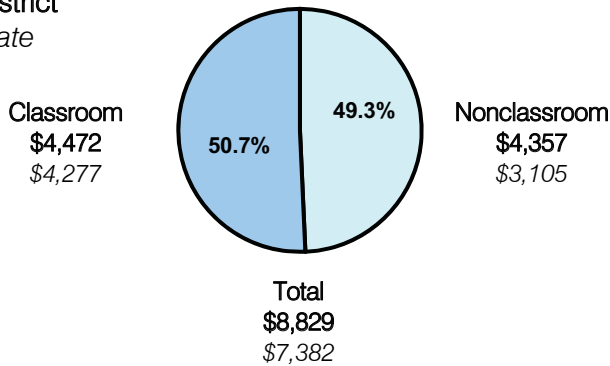

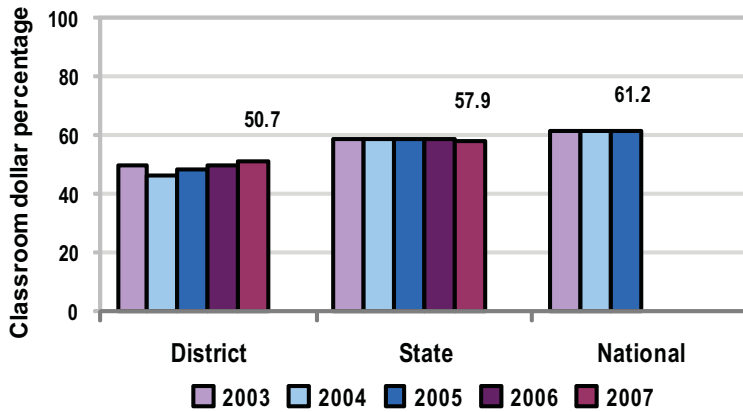

District-reported 2007 results

Teacher pay

- On average, each teacher earned an additional \$6,044 in salary.

Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on district, school, and individual performance.
- District and school performance goals were tied to the schools meeting Adequate Yearly Progress objectives and earning labels of "Performing" or better from ADE for AZ LEARNS.
- Schools had to achieve a student attendance rate of 90 percent or better.
- Teachers received acceptable performance evaluations and were compensated for tutoring students.

Menu

- Monies were used to increase teacher compensation.
- Monies were also used for professional development. Teachers participated in classroom coaching sessions with an educational consultant to improve lesson delivery and implement best practices in the classroom.
