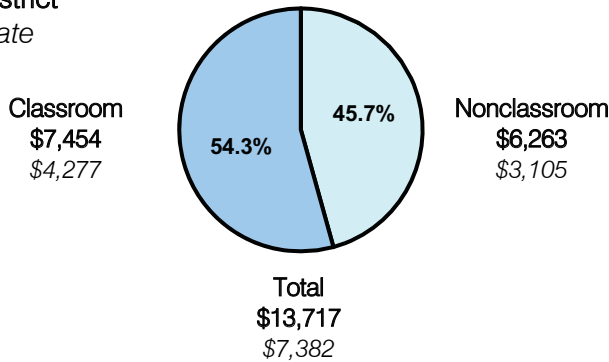

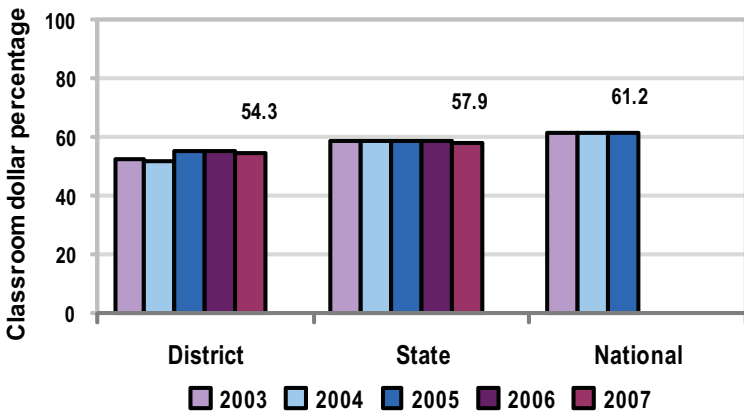
Fiscal year 2007 averages per pupil

District-reported 2007 results

Teacher pay

- On average, each teacher earned an additional \$1,940 in salary, the speech pathologist earned an additional \$1,532, and instructional aides earned an additional \$497, which includes performance pay for fiscal year 2006 performance.

Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were the same as the prior fiscal year's goals and were based on school and individual performance.
- Students demonstrated academic progress on standardized tests and district assessments.
- The results of a survey showed that at least 75 percent of parents were satisfied with the District.
- Standards for communication between school and home were achieved.

Menu

- Monies were used to hire 1 instructional aide to help reduce special needs classes in 1st through 4th grades.
