



Teacher pay

• On average, each teacher and counselor earned between \$8,478 and \$8,561 in additional salary.

Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were similar to the prior fiscal year's goals and were based on school and individual performance.
- Student achievement in reading, writing, and math was measured by standardized tests.
- Each school met Adequate Yearly Progress objectives.
- The District met state standards for dropout and graduation rates, and its absence rate was below 6 percent.
- Teachers aligned curriculum with state standards, attended professional development trainings, were involved in before- and after-school activities, increased communication with parents, and received satisfactory performance evaluations.
