



Teacher pay

• On average, each teacher, librarian, and English Language Learner Coordinator earned an additional \$3,283 in salary.

Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on district and individual performance.
- Students' reading scores on standardized tests improved, on average.
- Student absenteeism declined.
- 30 percent of teachers accomplished attendance goals.
- 91 percent of teachers received adequate performance evaluations and 93 percent of teachers accomplished personal goals.
- 11 teachers acted as grade-level mentors and representatives.
