## District-reported 2003 results

Teacher pay

- On average, each teacher, librarian, and English Language Learner Coordinator earned an additional $\$ 3,283$ in salary.


## Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on district and individual performance.
- Students' reading scores on standardized tests improved, on average.
- Student absenteeism declined.
- 30 percent of teachers accomplished attendance goals.
