



Teacher pay

 On average, each teacher, librarian, and counselor earned an additional \$3,622 in salary.

Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on district, school, and individual performance.
- 85 percent of students met achievement gains on standardized tests.
- 90 percent of teaching staff attended district inservice trainings on math or reading.
- 90 percent of participating teachers completed second drafts of subject-area curriculum maps.

 Monies were used solely to increase eligible employee compensation, which the District indicates may be partially responsible for a 30 percent reduction in teacher turnover.
