



# Teacher pay

 On average, each teacher earned an additional \$3,450 in salary.

### Performance

- The District accomplished some of its goals, which were based on district and individual performance.
- Teachers passed a 3-credit hour course and attended 2 in-service workshops.
- Teachers completed 15 hours of tutoring.
- The District did not meet its goal of earning a "Performing" or better label from ADE for AZ LEARNS and meeting Adequate Yearly Progress objectives.
