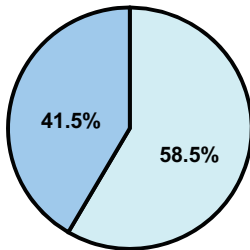

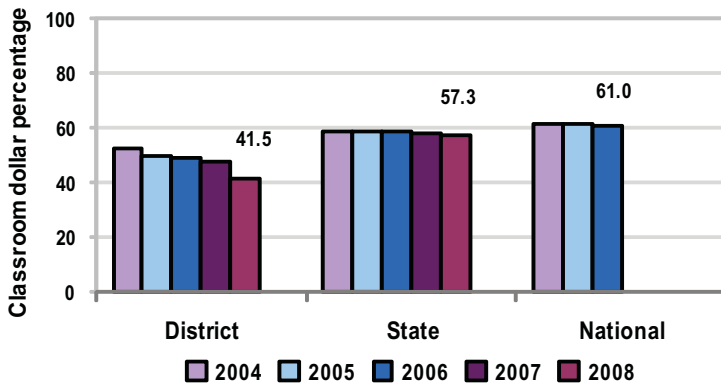

District-reported 2008 results

Teacher pay

- On average, each teacher earned an additional \$1,047 in salary, and a counselor earned an additional \$539.

Performance

- The District did not distribute any performance pay because it did not meet its goals, which required at least 50 percent of students taking the AIMS test to meet or exceed standards for at least 1 portion of the test—reading, writing, or math.

Menu

- Teachers earned additional compensation for exemplary attendance.
