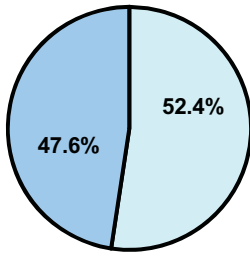

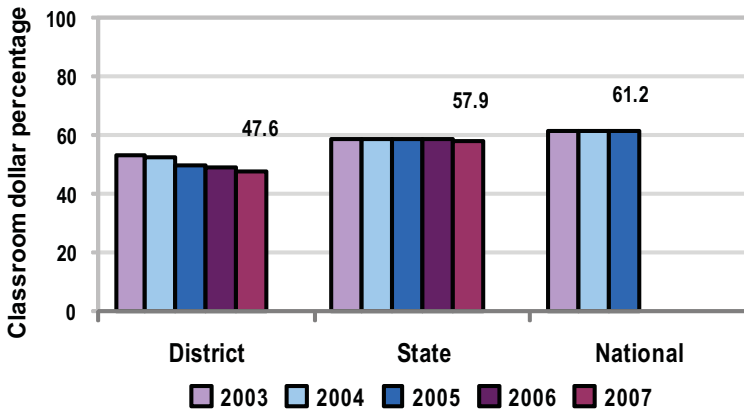

District-reported 2007 results

Teacher pay

- On average, each teacher and librarian earned an additional \$6,119 in salary.

Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on school and individual performance.
- Students' standardized test scores had to improve from the prior year.
- Teachers could take up to 2 sick or personal days without penalty.
- Students met the attendance goal.

Menu

- Monies were used solely to increase eligible employee compensation.
