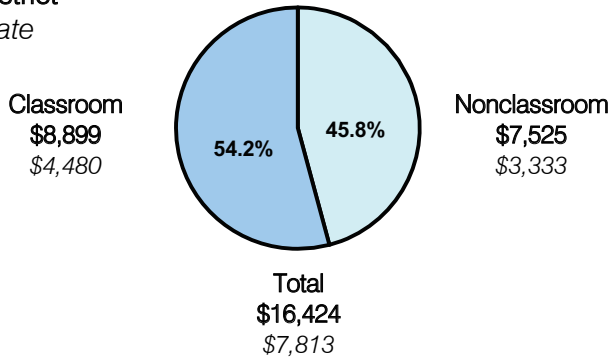

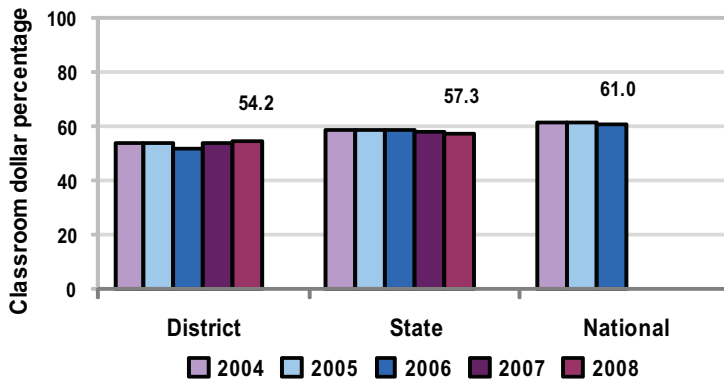

Teacher pay

- On average, each teacher earned an additional \$3,542 in salary.

Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on district, school, and individual performance.
- The District's schools met Adequate Yearly Progress objectives and received AZ LEARNS label of at least "Performing."
- Parents and students responding to a survey gave the District at least a 50 percent satisfaction rating.
- Teachers completed hours outside of instructional time for extracurricular activities.
- Other goals were linked to parent involvement and teacher evaluations.
