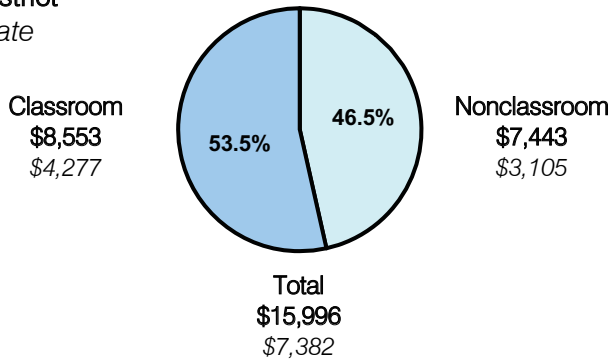

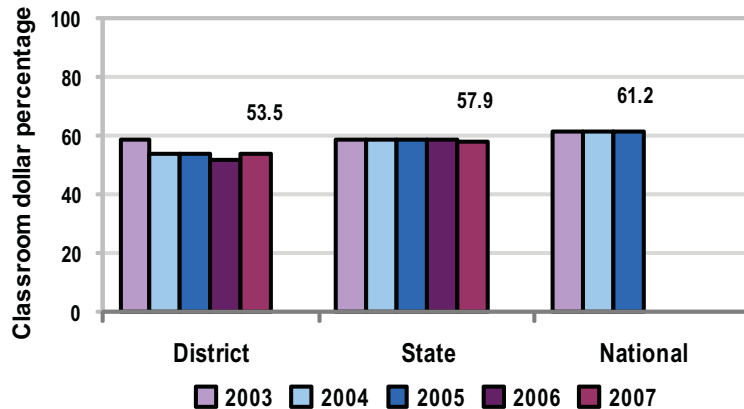

### Proposition 301

#### District-reported 2007 results

##### Teacher pay

- On average, each teacher earned an additional \$3,808 in salary.

##### Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on school and individual performance.
- The District's schools met Adequate Yearly Progress objectives and received AZ LEARNS labels of "Performing."
- Parents and students responding to a survey gave the District at least a 50 percent satisfaction rating.
- Teachers received satisfactory performance evaluations.
- Curriculum mapping was demonstrated through weekly lesson plans.

##### Menu

- Monies were used to compensate teachers for working additional hours outside of the regular school day. Teachers earned monies for participating in activities such as family nights, athletic events, committees, in-service trainings, and AIMS intervention activities.
