



Teacher pay

 On average, each teacher earned an additional \$3,808 in salary.

Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on school and individual performance.

- Parents and students responding to a survey gave the District at least a 50 percent satisfaction rating.
- Teachers received satisfactory performance evaluations.
