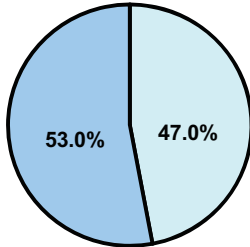

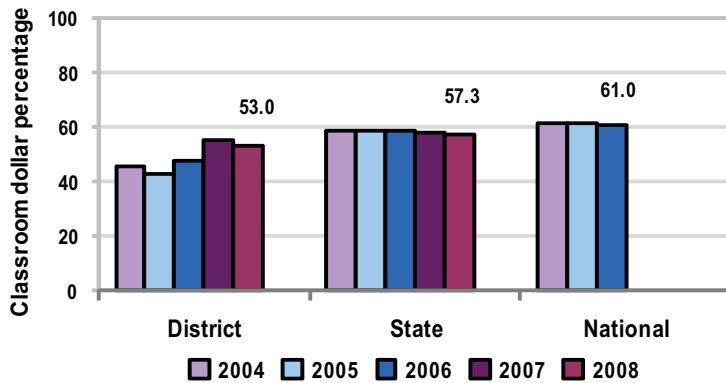

District-reported 2008 results

Teacher pay

- On average, each teacher earned an additional \$3,312 in salary, and each instructional aide earned an additional \$747.

Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on district and individual performance.
- Students demonstrated Adequate Yearly Progress.
- 92 percent of students met or exceeded AIMS test standards.
- The school maintained its "Highly Performing" label from ADE for AZ LEARNS.

Menu

- Teachers were compensated for participating in AIMS intervention and professional development activities.
- Monies were also used to compensate 2 bus drivers for driving students home from after-school AIMS intervention activities.
