Student enrollment decreased by 17 percent, which contributed to the 38 percent increase in total spending per pupil. Spending in the classroom increased overall from 50.7 to 53.1 percent. Spending on nonclassroom areas varied year to year, as is common for very small districts. Overall, spending on administration, plant operations, and food service decreased.
