

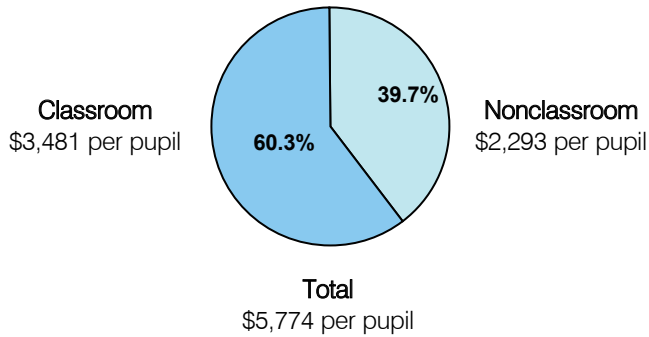

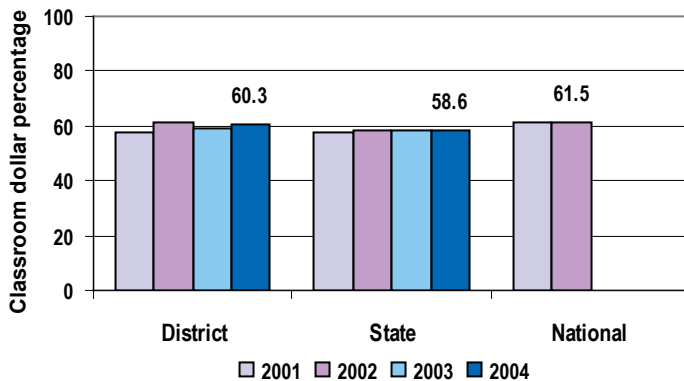

### Proposition 301

#### District-reported 2004 results

##### Teacher pay

- On average, each teacher, librarian, and counselor earned an additional \$4,975 in salary.

##### Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on school performance.
- Elementary-school students enrolled for the entire school year averaged 70 percent or higher on the District's assessment test.
- Junior-high school students posted gains of 10 percent or higher on pre- and post-tests.
- The High-school scored at the 75 percent level or higher on reading, writing, and math pre- and post-tests.

##### Menu

- Monies were used solely to increase eligible employee compensation.
