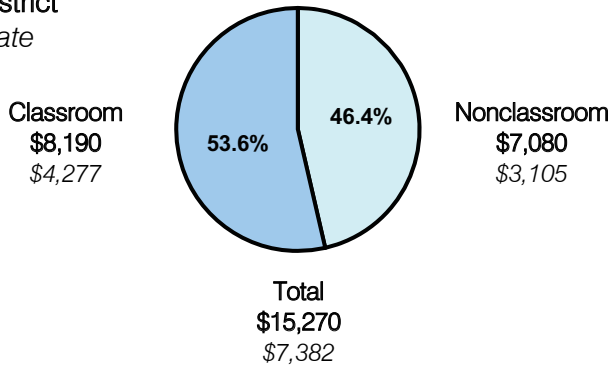

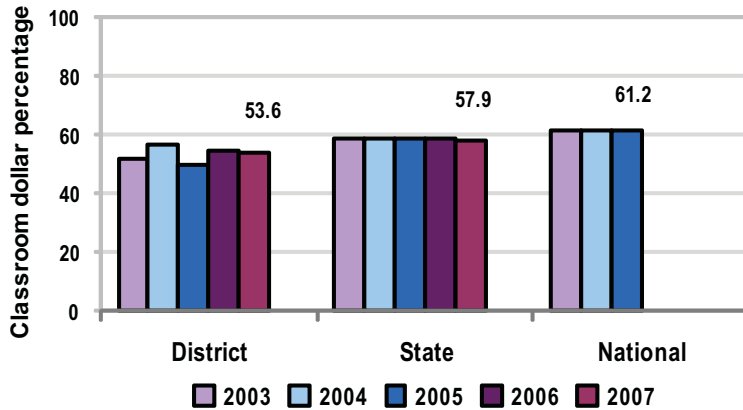

District-reported 2007 results

Teacher pay

- On average, each teacher earned an additional \$2,488 in salary, and instructional aides earned an additional \$2,042.

Performance

- The District accomplished all of its goals, which were based on district-level performance.
- The District's school earned a "Performing Plus" label from ADE for AZ LEARNS and demonstrated Adequate Yearly Progress.
- Students demonstrated growth in 4 state standards areas.
- Teachers maintained favorable performance evaluations, surveyed parents, students, and community members in order to understand the needs of the community, and implemented the Six-Trait writing method in classroom instruction.

Menu

- Teachers earned additional compensation by participating in at least 16 hours of professional development.
- Instructional aides earned additional compensation by planning and implementing a student garden club.
