



District-reported 2008 results

Teacher pay

 On average, each teacher, librarian, and counselor earned \$7,858 in additional salary.

Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were similar to the prior fiscal year's goals and were based on individual performance.
- Goals were linked to student achievement, with each teacher selecting specific classroom goals based on analysis of student data and test scores. At least 70 percent of students had to meet the goals for the teachers to receive performance pay. Students demonstrated goal achievement through pre- and post-test scores.

Menu

- Monies were used primarily to increase eligible employee compensation.
- An additional 3rd-grade teacher was hired to reduce class sizes from 29 students to 22.
