



Teacher pay

 On average, each teacher earned an additional \$2,470 in salary and each instructional aide earned an additional \$455, which included performance pay for fiscal year 2007 performance.

Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on district performance.
- The District's school earned at least an AZ LEARNS "Highly Performing" label and demonstrated Adequate Yearly Progress.
