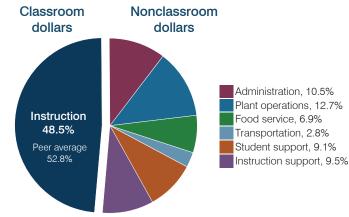

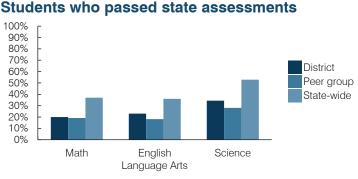

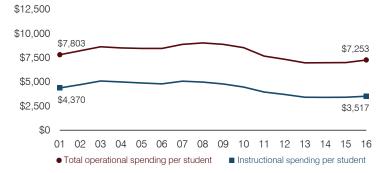

5-year spending trend (2011 through 2016)

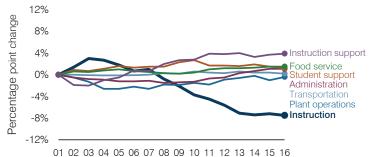
Administrative cost per pupil

Total operational spending per pupil, adjusted for inflation, decreased by 5 percent. The percentage of dollars spent in the classroom decreased from 51.5 to 48.5 percent. As a percentage of total operational spending, administration and plant operations increased and food service increased slightly. Student support decreased slightly, while other nonclassroom areas remained fairly stable.

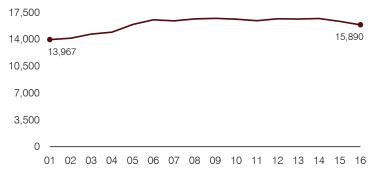
Total operational and instructional spending per pupil (inflation adjusted to 2016 dollars)

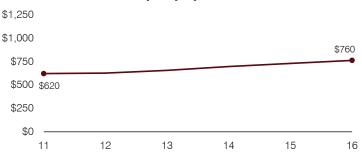


Changes in operational spending percentages

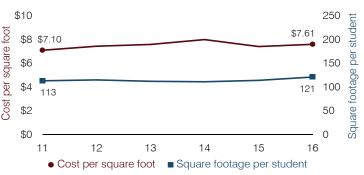

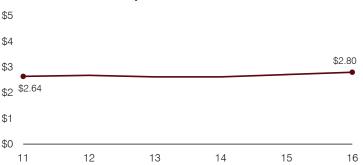




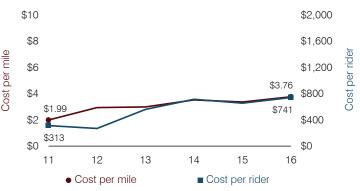
Plant cost per square foot and square footage per student
