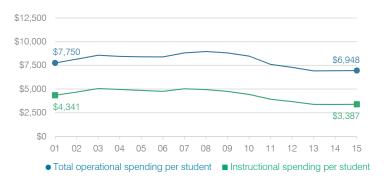

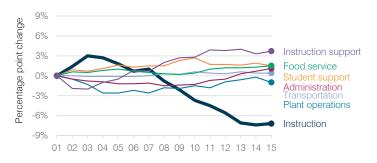
#### 5-year spending trend (2010 through 2015)

Total operational spending per pupil, adjusted for inflation, decreased by 18 percent. The percentage of dollars spent in the classroom decreased from 52.3 to 48.8 percent. As a percentage of total operational spending, administration increased substantially, food service increased, and instruction support increased slightly. Student support decreased, while the other nonclassroom areas remained stable.

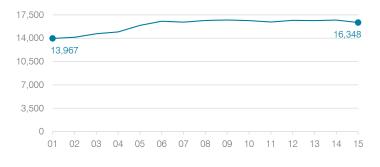
# Total operational and instructional spending per student (inflation adjusted to 2015 dollars)



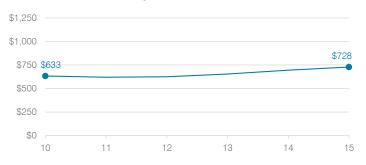
#### Changes in operational spending percentages



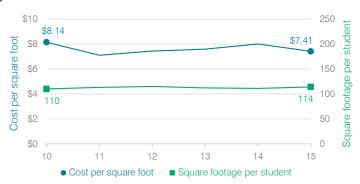
#### Students attending



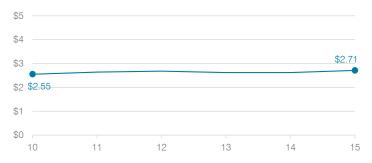
#### Administrative cost per student
