



Teacher pay

 On average, each teacher, librarian, and counselor earned an additional \$5,446 in salary, which includes performance pay for fiscal year 2006.

Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were similar to the prior fiscal year's goals and were based on district and individual performance.
- Student achievement data increased over the prior year.
- Student attendance was above 94 percent.
- 95 percent of parents participating in a satisfaction survey rated schools as satisfactory.
- Teachers developed professional investment plans, which included various components such as committee work, staff development, coordination, and acting as a liaison.
