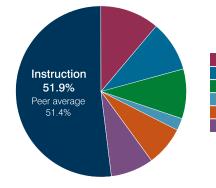

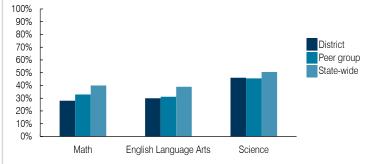

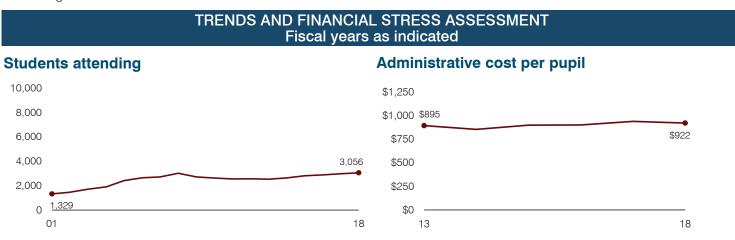

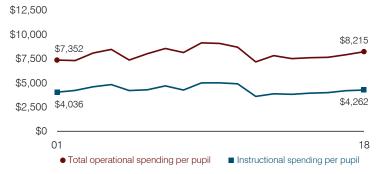

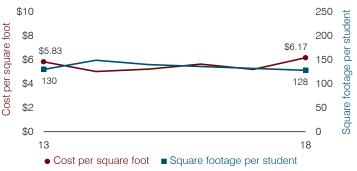


### Total operational and instructional spending

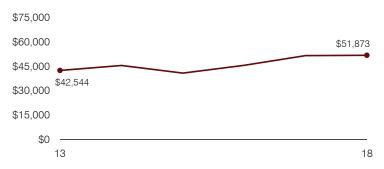

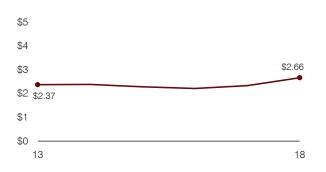
# Plant cost per square foot and square footage per student
