



Teacher pay

• On average, each teacher, librarian, counselor, and social worker earned an additional \$4,971 in salary.

Performance

- The District accomplished most of its goals, which were similar to the prior fiscal year's goals and were based on school performance.
- 3 of 4 schools were labeled "Performing" or better by ADE for AZ LEARNS and demonstrated Adequate Yearly Progress.
- The student attendance rate was at least 92 percent, the dropout rate was less than 6 percent, and the graduation rate was at least 90 percent.
- Other goals were related to parent-student satisfaction survey results and the reduced number of student suspensions.
