

Total spending per pupil decreased by 11 percent. Spending in the classroom was very inconsistent year to year, decreasing overall from 52.2 to 47.7 percent. Overall, spending on administration and transportation increased substantially and spending on food service increased, while spending on plant operations decreased substantially.








Administrative cost per student




Total operational and instructional spending per student




Plant cost per square foot and square footage per student




Changes in operational spending percentages
