



Teacher pay

 On average, each teacher earned an additional \$2,872 in salary.

Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on district performance.
- Students demonstrated adequate yearly progress in reading, writing, and math.
- Student absenteeism was less than 5.6 percent.

Menu

- Monies were used to increase teacher base pay.
- Additionally, the District used monies to pay for costs associated with professional development activities focused on reading, classroom management, and language arts. Teachers earned incentives for demonstrating, through classroom evaluations, that they implemented the training.
