



## **Proposition 301**

### District-reported 2008 results

### Teacher pay

 On average, each teacher, librarian, and counselor earned between \$3,327 and \$3,922 in additional salary, and each instructional aide earned an additional \$231.

### Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on school and individual performance.
- Standardized test scores were used to measure student improvement in math and reading.
- Teachers developed and maintained lesson plans and curriculum maps.

- Monies were used to increase eligible employee compensation.
- Teachers participated in professional development activities, such as Structured English Immersion training.
- The District also paid a consultant to help teachers with curriculum.
