

Total spending per pupil decreased by 4 percent. Spending in the classroom was very inconsistent year to year, decreasing overall from 56.3 to 52.5 percent. Spending on student support increased substantially and spending on food service increased, while spending on administration decreased slightly. Spending on most other nonclassroom areas varied year to year.



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




Administrative cost per student




Total operational and instructional spending per student




Plant cost per square foot and square footage per student




Changes in operational spending percentages
