



Teacher pay

 On average, each teacher, master teacher, and librarian earned between \$2,259 and \$2,800 in additional salary.

Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on school and individual performance.
- Each school developed grade-level goals aimed at increasing reading scores by 1 or more growth points as measured by reading assessments.
- Teachers attended 80 percent of districtsponsored professional development in-service trainings and participated in at least 1 local school committee.
