



### District-reported 2004 results

Teacher pay

• On average, each teacher earned an additional \$3,403 in salary, and each librarian, speech pathologist, audiologist, and counselor earned an additional \$2,835.

#### Performance

- Goals were linked to student achievement, teacher evaluations, tutoring, and parent-student satisfaction.
