

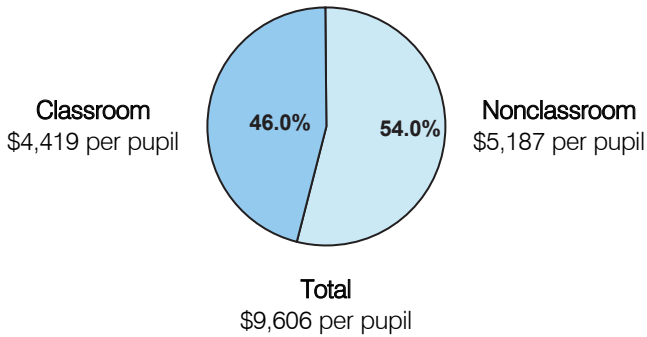

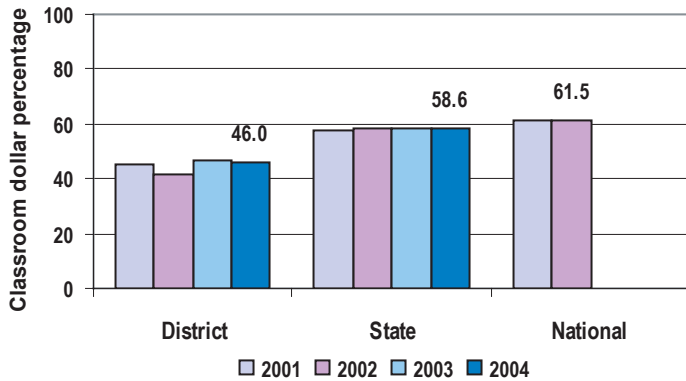

District-reported 2004 results

Teacher pay

- On average, each teacher earned an additional \$1,683 in salary.

Performance

- The District accomplished most of its goals, which were based on school and individual performance.
- Student achievement goals called for each student's reading, math, and language arts scores on standardized tests to be at or above the national average.
- Overall, students in grades 3, 5, and 6 accomplished all 3 goals, and students in grades 2, 4, and 7 accomplished 1 or more of the goals.
- 4 teachers each hosted at least 4 events to increase parent involvement.
- All teachers received acceptable performance evaluations.

Menu

- Monies continued to be used to pay a portion of an additional teacher's salary, which enabled the District to avoid combining 2 grades into 1 classroom.
