



Teacher pay

• On average, each teacher, librarian, speech pathologist, and counselor earned \$5,129 in additional salary.

Performance

- The District accomplished some of its goals, which were based on district, school, and individual performance.
- 2 of the District's 5 schools were labeled as "Performing" by ADE for AZ LEARNS.
- 1 school met Adequate Yearly Progress objectives.
- 90 percent of certified staff attended at least 12 hours of professional development activities that support state academic standards.
- Another goal was linked to parent-student satisfaction.

Menu

- Monies were primarily used to increase eligible employee compensation.
- Monies were also used to hire a 4th-grade teacher to reduce class sizes from 42 to 21 students.
