

Proposition 301 expenditures were 5.17 percent of the District's \$8,481,184 current operating expenditures in fiscal year 2002.

District-reported 2002 results

- On average, each teacher, counselor, and librarian earned an additional \$4,057 in compensation.
- An instructional aide for the 1st grade was hired, which reduced the ratio of students to adults from 25:1 to approximately 12:1.
- Teachers attended training sessions and conferences, and trainers were also brought to the District.
- Monies were also used to pay professional • development instructors and to enable teachers to attend trainings and conferences at other sites.
