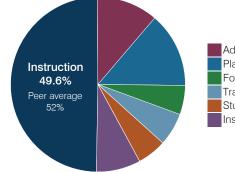

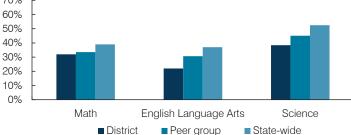

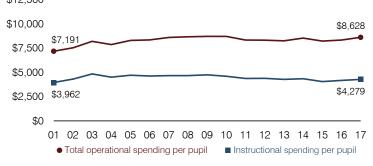
5-year spending trend (2012 through 2017)

Administrative cost per pupil

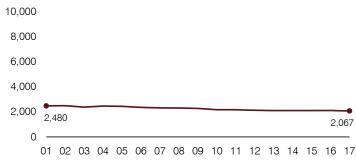
Total operational spending per pupil, adjusted for inflation, increased by 3 percent. The percentage of dollars spent on instruction decreased overall from 52.7 to 49.6 percent. Overall, as a percentage of total operational spending, student support increased substantially, administration increased, and plant operations and transportation increased slightly, while instruction support decreased substantially.

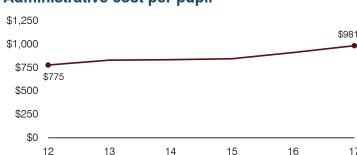

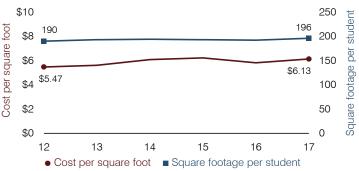

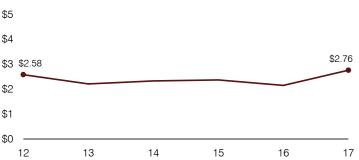


Plant cost per square foot and square footage per student

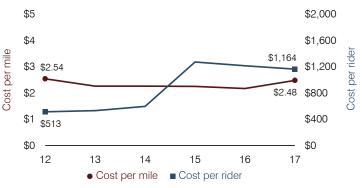
