



Teacher pay

 On average, each teacher earned an additional \$2,343 in salary, and each instructional aide earned an additional \$1,749.

Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on school performance.
- Students' reading and math scores improved on standardized tests.
- Student attendance increased through incentives for perfect or near-perfect attendance.
- Teachers developed and implemented at least 2 activities to involve students and parents.
- Teachers were required to provide additional attention to students having difficulties in any subject and to identify students at risk of dropping out.
- The graduation rate was 100 percent.
- All teachers maintained highly qualified status.
